Holocaust in Poland Re-examined: The Fate of Polish Jews Seen through the Lens of County-level Research

This panel presents a part of a large-scale research project, undertaken between 2014-18 by a group of researchers grouped around the Polish Center for Holocaust Research, of the Polish Academy of Sciences, based in Warsaw, Poland. The panel shall focus on four out of nine counties, which were included in our two-volume publication, *Night Without End. The Fate of the Jews in Selected Counties of Occupied Poland*, published in Poland, in Polish, in 2018. An English version of the book will be available shortly. In each and every of the studied counties the process of destruction of the Jews followed its distinct path, and was reflective of the local conditions. Nevertheless, regardless of local variations, at the end of the day, in all cases, an overwhelming majority of the Jews have been killed. The papers will present these unique local conditions which impacted the policies of extermination and which did have an influence on the individual fates of the Jews.
